The Institute of Public Health of the Jagiellonian University Medical College is committed to making its emundus.izp.cm-uj.krakow.pl website accessible, in accordance with the Act of April 4, 2019 on digital accessibility of websites and mobile applications of public entities. This declaration of accessibility applies to the emundus.izp.cm-uj.krakow.pl website run by the Institute of Public Health of the Jagiellonian University.

Reporting accessibility problems with this website

Everyone has the right to request that the digital accessibility of the website, mobile application or any of their elements be made available. You can also request information to be made available in a different format, such as reading a digitally unavailable document, describing the content of the film without audio description, etc. The request should contain the personal contact information of the person submitting the request, an indication of which website or mobile application is meant and the method of contact. If the requesting person reports the need to receive information in an alternative form, he/she should also specify the form of this information.

The public entity should fulfill the request immediately and no later than within 7 days. If meeting this deadline is not possible, the public entity will immediately inform about when it will be possible to fulfill the request, and the deadline may not be longer than 2 months. If ensuring accessibility is not possible, the public entity may propose an alternative way of accessing the information.

Enforcement procedure

In the event that the entity refuses to comply with the request to ensure accessibility or provide alternative access to information, a complaint may be made against that entity.

Architectural accessibility

The seat of the Institute of Public Health of the Jagiellonian University Medical College is located at Skawińska 8, in Krakow.

There is an elevator in the building where the Institute of Public Health of the Jagiellonian University Medical College is located. The building is not equipped with Braille signage, nor are there any contrast or enlarged print markings for the blind and sight impaired. There are also no restrooms adapted for people with disabilities.

The Institute of Public Health of the Jagiellonian University Medical College does not have access to its own car park, there are nearby municipal parking spaces.

The Institute of Public Health of the Jagiellonian University Medical College does not provide the possibility of communication through a sign language interpreter.
